UNITED WORKERS PARTY AWARDS CRITERIA

Who can be nominated: ANY member or supporter of the United Workers Party (UWP) whether living in Saint Lucia or the diaspora. The individual should meet all the criteria for the award being considered. An individual could be nominated for multiple awards. However, each nomination must be completed on a separate form. Carefully review the criteria to determine which award is best suited for the individual being considered as a potential awardee.
